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### **Executive Summary**

As a functional association in Göttingen, we have contributed towards helping the growing Indian community for social activities and offered support to incoming and existing Indians in Göttingen. NIRMITI has been organized cultural, educational and sportive events in the year 2017-18. We organized ten events, in which two events were organized in collaboration with the International Office, University of Göttingen Germany and Centre for International Migration and Development (CIM). The events ranged from casual day-trips, hiking, cultural, potluck dinners, sportive and educational events. We also attended the ISG meetings held in Bonn and Munich. These organized events were well-received by the public. We have welcomed gathering of more than 100 people, including Germans and people from other countries as well.

## **NIRMITI**

NIRMITI is an association of Indians living in Göttingen, Germany. We are a group of students, scientists, working professionals and families. NIRMITI brings together members of Göttingen's growing Indian community for social activities and offers support to incoming and resident Indians in the city.

The Association came into existence in the year 2009 with the support of more than a hundred Indians living in Göttingen. Our purpose is to create an environment of mutual support, offer opportunities for social interaction, and to assist in the exchange of social, cultural and scientific values between India and Germany. The association's name, 'NIRMITI', means 'creation' and its logo, a picture of hand supporting a growing-seedling and the alphabets of NIRMITI etched in colors of Indian and German national flags. that signify the mutual support and cooperation between the Indo-German communities. The statement 'Indian Fraternity in Göttingen' inscribed below in the logo defines its edifice. We have been an active community for the past several years, supporting and organizing several events to foster a sense of community among our members. The core committee members are elected yearly through election and executive members join committee voluntarily.

**Vision**: To support incoming and resident Indians in Goettingen.

**Mission**: To create an environment of mutual support, offer opportunities for social interaction, and to assist in the exchange of social, cultural and scientific values between India and Germany.

We are a nonprofit, volunteer-run association that organizes events with the support of the International Office, University of Göttingen, Germany.

#### **Events organized in the year 2017-18**

In the year 2017-18, NIRMITI organized ten events, in which two events were organized in collaboration with International Office, University of Göttingen, Germany and Centre for International Migration and Development (CIM). NIRMITI also attended and represented in two events in 2017-2018. The events ranged from casual day-trips, cultural, national and sports events, and professional development events.

#### I. Day Trips

#### 1. Hike to Titan RT

NIRMITI organized, on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2017, a hike to Titan-RT, in which 16 enthusiasts visited 458.5 m long pedestrian suspension bridge at Harz Mountains, opened in 2017. The cable bridge is in the areas of Oberharz am Brocken and Thale in the Saxon-Anhalt region of Harz. The bridge hangs over the part of the reservoir of the Wendefurth dam, which is connected

We invited Dr. Muralee Thummarukudy, Chief of Disaster Risk Reduction, United Nations Environment Program, Geneva. He provided guidance on



current trends in job market and career prospective in United Nations and International Civil Service. He emphasized on women empowerment and entrepreneurial ventures. Dr. Muralee also shared his experience in post-disaster response and follow up of almost all major disasters of the twenty-first century.

## 2. Weekend sports


