Applicants from EU-countries who have not completed their B.Sc. yet by the time of application must prove a minimum of 150 ECTS. The BSc certificate plus final transcript must then be submitted latest within 4 weeks after the lectures have started.	
For China, Mongolia, India and Vietnam , only <u>APS-proven</u> academic transcript and degree certificates are accepted for application.
