Important to know (partner & students):

For students who are studying at a European university but are a national of a country outside the EU and EEA, we are obliged to register you with the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF). Therefore, we need the following documents 6 weeks before you come to Göttingen.

- Residence title of the EU country in which you are studying. The residence title must be issued for study purposes
- 2. Passport or ID
- 3. Proof of financial means showing that you have at least € 934 per month to support yourself (e.g. copy of bank statement, scholarship, or letter from parents
- 4. Proof of health insurance (EHIC card, otherwise a German statutory health insurance is strongly suggested)
- 5. Home address and your address in Göttingen, if you already have one
- 6. Complete address of your home university

After the approval of the BAMF, there is no need to apply for a visa for study purposes in Germany.
