How to Apply

On-Campus Housing

On-campus housing includes space at RH3 or The Quarters through UM.

There are limited spaces available on campus due to the high number of new freshmen attending UM in Academic Year 2024/25.

If you are interested in on-campus housing, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Have access to your UM WebID and password.
 - When you were admitted, you received an email from helpdesk@olemiss.edu with instructions to set up your WebID. Check your junk/spam folders!
- 2. Contact exchange@olemiss.edu to be sent the application instructions. Assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis.



Off-Campus Housing

Students should contact their preferred off-campus housing complex directly to apply.

Each off-campus housing complex has a different application process. Generally, they are online applications.

Read through your lease carefully. These are legally binding contracts, deposits, and more. You are responsible for the fees included in the lease for the term of the lease.

Communicate clearly about the lease terms. If you are only at UM for one semester, confirm that you are signing up for a short-term lease, not the full year!

UM employees cannot serve as guarantors for incoming students.
