News from the GGNB Board (February 2024)

1. GGNB Budget 2024

The GGNB Board has approved the budget for 2024.

In total, 61 stipend months will be available for Bridging Funds in 2024. The application deadlines are 31 March, 30 June, 30 September, 31 December.

For all programs except IMPRS, MolMed and iRTG 2172, there will now be application deadlines for travel grants as well: 31 March, 30 June, 30 September, 31 December. The applications have to be sent to ggnb@gwdg.de, and will be forwarded to the respective program for decision.

The budget for travel grants is limited. Only applications for conference visits with an own contribution can be granted (poster or/and talk). For trips costing less than 500 EUR, the full amount may be granted (pending the availability of funds). For trips costing more than 500 EUR, max. 65% of the total costs but not more than 800 EUR/1000 EUR may be granted (depending on the program, pending the availability of funds). Applications from junior research groups may be given priority. The programs are free to set further criteria for travel grants.

2. Save the date: Scientific Advisory Board Meeting and GGNB Science Day, 22 November 2024

The next meeting of the Scientific Advisory Board and GGNB Science Day will take place on 22 November 2024. A poster session is planned for the morning and a Science Slam for the afternoon. In addition, several GGNB alumni will be invited to join (career-related) activities. Further information will follow in due course.

3. Predatory publishing

The GGNB Board stresses that supervisors should raise awareness of problematic publishing practices. Relevant resources should be used to assess if a journal or a conference are trustworthy and adhere to the standards of the field (e.g., https://thinkchecksubmit.org/ for publications or https://thinkcheckattend.org/ for conferences).

4. Cumulative thesis

The GGNB Board stresses that in PhD theses, own contributions have to be indicated explicitly and in great detail by the doctoral students. The examination board and especially the supervisor have to verify that there is no overlap with previous (or future) dissertations.

Journals have certain formats for the specification of own contributions to manuscripts. These may serve as templates to specify the doctoral student's own contribution in the dissertation.
