Application process	1 <sup>st</sup> semester or year's exchange: <b>30<sup>th</sup> April 2025</b> 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester exchange: <b>1<sup>st</sup> October 2025</b>	
	After receiving the nomination from the student's home university, the students will receive the application instructions via email. Students are asked to await those instructions before starting the application. Once the instructions e-mail is sent, the nomination and exchange are confirmed.	
Courses for incoming exchange	List of Courses for Exchange Students Each year around July 15 <sup>th</sup> the above link will be updated to read the program for next academic year. Only minor changes are to be expected. Courses available to incoming exchange students are taught on <b>Master level</b> . The min. workload is <b>24 ECTS</b> / semester.	
Recommended language level	The recommended level of English for students nominated to our Faculty is level B2, in order to successfully follow our Faculty courses, all taught in <b>English</b> . We do not require an English proficiency certificate, but do trust our partners to consider the language requirement when selecting their students.
