An Online Institutional Visit-cum-Information Session at Jadavpur  
University  
February 26, 2021 from 04:00-05:30 P.M.IST (11:30h CET)**

India has recently emerged as an important scientific and technological leading country through its impressive and growing network of excellent universities and institutions. As such, University of Göttingen has selected India as one of the key strategic regions for academic cooperation establishing the University of Göttingen India Office in 2008 and the Centre for Modern Indian Studies (CeMIS) at the University of Göttingen Campus. The main objective of the Göttingen India Office is to facilitate, coordinate and support academic exchange activities and cooperation projects with partner institutions in India. The Centre for Modern Indian Studies (CeMIS) is dedicated to research and teaching about economic and political development in modern India.

One of the Göttingen -India academic exchange activities include the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and the German Ministry of Education and Research funded "A New Passage to India" project ("DE/IN CeMIS" 2019–2023) which further enhances cooperation with CeMIS' 14 partner institutions in India including Jadavpur University. The fact that a number of CeMIS and DAAD alumni have moved into professorships at Indian universities and are now project partners in the "DE/IN CeMIS" project illustrates the sustainability and development of our growing academic networks with India. DE/IN CeMIS provides scholarship for both German and Indian students and scientists to spend a mobility period in Germany and in India in order to enhance their academic knowledge.

Due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, Göttingen India Office is no longer able to conduct the monthly on site institutional visits-cum-information sessions at Indian partner institutions. Instead, the Göttingen India Office has decided to conduct this online information session to reach out to students, researchers and faculty members from Jadavpur University with an opportunity to study and research in Göttingen. This event will also include a session on study opportunity at Jadavpur University for participating Göttingen students.
