You are interested in strengthening your social media writing skills by learning and developing your own social media strategy?

The Department of 'Intercultural Interaction' of the University of Göttingen in collaboration with the Centre for Academic Writing and Communication at the University of Tartu and the Ghent University Writing Mentor Programme present the teaching and learning project:

ENLIGHT Challenges go Social Media

In this intercultural virtual exchange project with 25 students (BA., MA., PhD.) from three different universities and study programmes, you can develop and strengthen your social media writing skills and your intercultural competence by working collaboratively on one of the **ENLIGHT** challenges, by posting actively on social media and becoming a globally engaged citizen in critical thinking. You will gain theoretical and practical knowledge on developing a social media strategy and you will learn how to create interesting headlines and attributes that make a publication go viral. In this challenge-based intercultural learning environment you will choose collaboratively one challenge, narrow it down to a smaller topic, do research and come up with a solution. In the next step, you will develop a social media strategy for raising awareness, create a new professional social media account (e. g. Instagram) and by putting into practice the theoretical knowledge, you will promote the solution you have come up with. In the meantime, you will take part in virtual workshops on various topics, such as intercultural teamwork, constructive feedback, writing and creating social media posts as well as the online learning platform. In small intercultural working groups, you can bring to the project your perspective and enable therefore a broad interdisciplinary discussion.

The project offers you the opportunity to engage in an intercultural learning experience, to be active in your own research project, to write and plan collaboratively and to gain authentic readers. By participating in the project and submitting a portfolio you can earn 4 ECTS Credits in the key competencies².
