Starting September 2024, with potential for longer involvement.

- 1) **Teaching support** (140 hours), Module MINC 1006 “Data analysis for field biologists”: We are looking for a tutor of a data science and statistics block course. You need to have R skills and be available on weekdays in the period 11-29 November 2024. Tasks: student support in the classroom, evaluation of the submitted coursework.
- 2) **Sample preparation** for DNA barcoding of Lepidoptera (moths): You would ideally have previous lab experience with techniques such as sample preparation for PCR and DNA extraction, or at least some general lab experience. Up to 200 hours (can be split among several students), flexible over the winter semester.
- 3) **Data mobilization, extraction and entry**: For projects on historical population trends in birds and butterflies, we are looking for organized, focused students with an eye for detail. Previous experience with databases and data handling are beneficial but no precondition. Flexible amount of hours, positions will be available well into 2025.
