- cc. Modules can be selected from the university's language offer, provided that they are modules that teach a language level equivalent to level B according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and provided that the modules have not already been included in a previously completed degree program.
 - Modules relating to English as well as the mother tongue of the student are excluded.
- dd. Students who acquired their university entrance qualification neither in the Federal Republic of Germany nor in another country or region in which German is the official language and for whom the degree programme that represents the basis for entry into the Master's programme "Development Economics" was not completed in the German language, can also acquire 12 C in the elective area by successfully completing the modules offered in the program "German as a foreign language". Modules from level "Basic level II" (A.1.2) or higher can be included. (NEW since 23.09.24)
- ee. The certificate program "Fachliches und Literarisches Übersetzen" (SK.FLÜ) can be chosen to the extent of 18 C, provided that the necessary admission requirements are met. The inclusion of partial credits from the program is excluded.
- ff. The certificate program "Zusatzqualifikation Interkulturalität und Mehrsprachigkeit/Deutsch als Fremd-und Zweitsprache" (SK.IKG-ZIMD) can be chosen to the extent of 18 C, provided that the necessary admission requirements are met. The inclusion of partial credits from the program is excluded.

6. Master's thesis (30 C)

30 C are awarded for the successful completion of the master's thesis.

The prerequisite for admission to the Master's thesis is the acquisition of 18 C from the compulsory area and 6 C through the successful completion of a seminar in the compulsory elective area.
