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#### **INTRODUCTION**

The SCIP project ("Causes and Consequences of Socio-Cultural Integration Processes among New Immigrants in Europe") is the first comparative survey among new arrivals in Europe. The SCIP project is generously funded by the NORFACE research programme on Migration in Europe – Social, Economic, Cultural and Policy Dynamics. Co-ordinated by Claudia Diehl (University of Konstanz), the SCIP project has been conducted by researchers at Bamberg University, Göttingen University, the Netherlands Institute for Social Research, Utrecht University, Essex University, the London School of Economics and Social Sciences, Trinity College Dublin, and the Economic and Social Research Institute.

The SCIP survey has been conducted in four countries: Germany, The Netherlands, United Kingdom, and Ireland. In a mini-panel design, immigrants have been interviewed 12 months maximum after their arrival (first wave) and one and a half year later (second wave). The following immigrants groups have been selected for interviews: Poles (in Germany, Netherlands, United Kingdom, Ireland), Turks (Germany, Netherlands), Antilleans (Netherlands), Bulgarians (Netherlands), Moroccans (Netherlands), Surinamese (Netherlands), Pakistanis (United Kingdom).

The survey instrument has been designed to cover a wide array of items including migration biography, social networks, religious practices, cultural identities, educational background, and socioeconomic positions. To facilitate broader comparisons, questions were adopted from established survey instruments such as New Immigrant Survey, the European Social Survey, or the World Values Survey.

This document presents the survey instrument used in the first wave, conducted in 2010/2011. While all interviews were conducted in the respective first languages, the document presents the English language version.



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### **USER INSTRUCTIONS**

The SCIP questionnaire document presents the survey instrument used by all countries in the first wave, conducted in 2010/2011. The document is designed not only to present an overview of all questions but also to facilitate use of the SCIP dataset. Therefore, it includes questions wording, interviewer instructions and answer categories as well as information on variable names, labels and values, on filters, and on country-specific questions which help users navigate the datasets of each country. The following chart gives instructions on how to read the information contained in the questionnaire.
