## **Course Description**

The 17 Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations are an urgent call for action. In this course, you will work together with students from our partner university (University of Amsterdam, UvA) and other disciplines. With your virtual team you will address global challenges, while taking into account both local and international contexts. How can you best combine your interdisciplinary and cultural backgrounds to contribute to solving complex global problems, such as climate change, economic inequality, digitalization and gender inequality. During the course you will be educated in intercultural competence and social entrepreneurship. While you will work virtually with your team, classes will mostly be on campus for UniGoe students.
