"Reaccreditation"?

The University is required to regularly review degree programmes: is the programme doable, and can students complete the requirements within a given time frame? Does the programme fit legal requirements? Does it meet the structural target? If so, the study programme is (re-) accredited - it receives an official certificate. If not, the accreditation body requires changes and sees to their implementation before the certificate is granted. For the programme review, students and staff members regularly come together in discussion rounds.



The Story So Far

Since summer semester 2020 the English Department has engaged in a series of discussion rounds, reviewing the degree programmes offered at the Department. By now we have covered all criteria the University expects us to discuss.
